**1. NO ENTRY FEE**

**REGISTRATION DAY – SUNDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 10AM  
TO 3PM IN THE PAVILION.**

**ENTRIES CLOSE:**

- **Friday 03.11.23** @ 9.00am for Horticulture, Farm Produce, Fruit & Vegetables.
- Please refer to individual sections for information regarding close date and time.

2. Judging will be performed by a panel of judges appointed by Tweed River Agricultural Society.
3. No prize money will be awarded for any class.
4. All Exhibits must be a bona fide work of the Exhibitor, grown or made by the individual.
5. Exhibits must be prepared by non-professionals.
6. All Exhibits must have been completed within the last two years and not previously won a prize at the Murwillumbah Show.
7. All exhibits will remain on display until dismantling on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> November when they will be removed under supervision of the Steward.

8. No exhibit may compete in more than one class.
9. Adult exhibitors may only compete in Open classes but Children can compete in Children's and Open classes.
10. **Deliveries will not be accepted** at the Secretary's Office at the Showground.
11. **PLEASE REFER TO INDIVIDUAL SECTIONS FOR INFORMATION REGARDING EXHIBIT DELIVERY TIMES AND DROP-OFF POINTS.**
12. All exhibits must be picked up on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> November between 9.00am and 11.00am from the Pavilion.

### PRIZES:

- Champion Ribbon (Highest cumulative score over multiple classes) plus bee themed gift valued at \$50.

1. All honey is to be in standard 500gm glass jars with white lid, free of any labelling or markings.
2. Standard competition jars are available by contacting the Steward, Leonie on 0428 177 450 \$1.50 each.
3. Each jar should have a piece of paper wrapped around it with the Section Name, Exhibitor's Name and your Exhibitor Number and attached by a rubber band.
4. Only one entry per person, per class is allowed.
5. Frame of Combed Honey – Must be free of paper and decorative borders so that all the comb surface can be judged. Frames to be exhibited in a single frame observatory case.
6. Where there are less than 3 entries in a class, that class might not be judged.

- S12.1** Liquid Honey - Light
- S12.2** Liquid Honey - Amber/Golden
- S12.3** Liquid Honey - Dark
- S12.4** Cut Comb in Honey
- S12.5** Creamed Honey
- S12.6** Frame of Combed Honey (full depth) in display case
- S12.7** Block of Bees Wax (at least 500g)
- S12.8** Decorative Bees Wax (1 item)
- S12.9** Honey Mead (presented in a Clear Bottle minimum 375ml)
- S12.10** Stingless Bee (Native, Sugarbag) Honey, minimum 25g sample in small clear jar.
- S12.11** Any honey variety from an exhibitor under 18 years
